## BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BBA) IN GENERAL BUSINESS AT GRIFFIN

### GENERAL EDUCATION (GENED) CORE CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS

See UGA Bulletin ([bulletin.uga.edu](http://bulletin.uga.edu)) for course options in each General Education Area.

#### GENED I - FOUNDATION COURSES (9 HOURS)

- ENGL 1101 English Composition I (Grade of C or better is required)
- ENGL 1102 English Composition II (Average of 2.0 or better is required for both ENGL 1101/1102)
- MATH 1101 or MATH 1113\*

\*A grade or exemption in MATH 1113 is a Terry College graduation requirement.

#### GENED II - SCIENCES (7-8 HOURS) AT LEAST ONE COURSE MUST INCLUDE A LABORATORY.

- Physical Sciences (3-4 hours)
- Life Sciences (3-4 hours)

#### GENED III - QUANTITATIVE REASONING (3-4 HOURS)

- MATH 1113\*

\*A grade or exemption in MATH 1113 is a Terry College graduation requirement.

*If MATH 1113 is used to satisfy GenEd Area I, choose one of the courses listed in the UGA Bulletin classified to satisfy GenEd Area III.*

#### GENED IV - WORLD LANGUAGES AND CULTURE, HUMANITIES AND THE ARTS (12 HOURS)

- World Languages and Culture (3 courses, 9 hours total)
- Humanities and the Arts (3 hours)

*BBA degree requirement course COMM 1110 (Public Speaking) or COMM 1500 (Interpersonal Communication) is preferred in GenEd IV Humanities for the Terry College. It must be taken as an Arts and Sciences Elective or General Elective credit, if not satisfied as part of GenEd IV Humanities.*

#### GENED V - SOCIAL SCIENCES (9 HOURS)

- Social Science Electives (3 courses, 9 hours total)

*Students who have not met the Georgia and U.S. Constitution requirement by examination should enroll in POLS 1101 or POLS 1101E or POLS 1105H. A passing grade on an examination on the history of the United States and Georgia is required to satisfy the United States and Georgia History Requirement for all persons receiving a baccalaureate degree from the University, unless exempted by one of the following courses: HIST 2111, HIST 2111E, HIST 2111H, HIST 2112, HIST 2112E, HIST 2112H, HIST 3080H.*

#### GENED VI - RELATED TO THE MAJOR (18 HOURS)

- ACCT 2101 Principles of Accounting I
- ACCT 2102 Principles of Accounting II (prerequisite: ACCT 2101)
- ECON 2105 Principles of Macroeconomics
- ECON 2106 Principles of Microeconomics
- LEGL 2700 Legal and Regulatory Environment of Business
- MIST 2090 Introduction to Information Systems in Business

### ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Completion of Core Areas I-VI, 60 hours earned, and a transfer overall grade point average of 2.80. Students may apply if they are enrolled in course work that fulfills these outstanding requirements. Acceptance in the major is contingent on satisfactory completion of in-progress work.

### UPPER DIVISION BUSINESS CORE (12 HOURS)

- FINA 3000 Financial Management
- MGMT 3000 Principles of Management
- MARK 3000 Principles of Marketing
- MSIT 3000 Statistical Analysis for Business I

### UPPER DIVISION GENERAL ELECTIVES (12 HOURS)

Four (3-hour) courses required. Choose from 4000-level or above Terry College prefix courses outside the major and/or 3000-level or above Terry College Prefix courses (ACCT, ECON, ENTR, FINA, ILAD, LEGL, MARK, MGMT, MIST, MSIT, REAL, or RMIN). Students may also choose 3000-level or above courses other than Terry College prefixes. Any 3000-level or above transfer course may be used to satisfy Upper Division General Electives.

### MAJOR REQUIRED COURSES (21 HOURS)

Courses must be satisfied with a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher.

Choose seven (3 hour) business courses 4000-level or above from the following, with no more than three courses from any one business prefix: ACCT, BUSN, ECON, ENTR, FINA, ILAD, INTB, LEGL, MARK, MGMT, MIST, MSIT, REAL, RMIN. General Business majors may also choose up to two 3-hour courses (6 hours) of 3000 level or higher FHCE coursework to satisfy Major Required area.

*NOTE: In the Major Required Area and General Electives Area combined, choose no more than five courses, 4000-level or above, from any one business prefix.*

### ARTS AND SCIENCES ELECTIVES (15 HOURS)

Terry College majors are required to satisfy 15 hours (1000 – 5000 level) of Arts and Sciences Electives. Transfer coursework is accepted. Choose from the following prefixes: AFAM, AFST, AMHA, ANTH, ARAB, ARED, ARGD, ARHI, ARID, ARST, ARTI, ASTR, BCMB, BENG, BINF, BIOL, CBIO, CHEM, CHNS, CLAS, CMLT, COMM, DANC, DRAM, ECOL, ECON, EMUS, ENGL, ENTO, FANR, FCID, FILM, FREN, FRES, FYOS, GENE, GEOG, GEOL, GPST, GREK, GRMN, HEBR, HIST, HNDI, HONS, INDO, INTL, INTS, ISCI, ITAL, JPNS, KREN, LACS, LATN, LING, MAND, MARS, MATH, MIBO, MUSI, NAMS, PASH, PBIO, PERS, PHIL, PHYS, POLS, PORT, PSYC, PTSP, RELI, ROML, RUSS, SCAN, SEMI, SLAV, SOCI, SPAN, STAT, SWAH, THEA, TURK, URDU, VIET, WMST, YORB, ZULU and several AIRS and MILS courses - see UGA Bulletin for full list.

### REQUIRED FOR A BBA DEGREE

- Lower Division General Education Core Curriculum Courses (minimum 58-60 hours)
- Upper Division and Major Courses (minimum 60 hours)
- Physical Education (1 hour)
- Total Required for a BBA - 121 Semester Hours (including 1 hr PE)

- Federal Constitution Exam (may be satisfied with POLS 1101)
- Georgia Constitution Exam (may be satisfied with POLS 1101, if taken in Georgia)
- Environmental Literacy Requirement
- Cultural Diversity Requirement
- Physical Education - one hour
- UGA Residency: 45 of last 60 semester hours earned (15 of last 20 three-hour courses are to be satisfied at UGA)
- 2.00 University of Georgia cumulative average for graduation certification
- Experiential Learning Requirement (for matriculates for Fall 2016 and after)
